Biographic Sketch

Walter P. Krolikowski was born in Chicago on September 9, 1923. He attended St. Ignatius High School, then Chicago Teachers College (now Chicago State University) until he was drafted into the army in 1943. After recovering from a war injury, Krolikowski entered the Society of Jesus in 1946. He served as a freshman dean at Xavier University before coming to Loyola University Chicago as the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences in 1963.

Rev. Krolikowski resigned as dean in 1970 in order to pursue a full-time position as a professor in the School of Education. He taught courses on the philosophy, foundations, and history of education, while also offering non-credit courses in Gregorian Chant at Loyola. In the 1990s, Krolikowski formed and conducted a staff choir at the Loyola Water Tower Campus.

Along with his work and research in the School of Education, Rev. Krolikowski was an active member of the Philosophy of Education Society, where he organized annual conferences hosted by Loyola. In addition, Rev. Krolikowski spent many summers abroad in Rome working on a Jesuit dictionary project. Part of Rev. Krolikowski's Jesuit work involved regularly leading masses in Spanish at Holy Rosary Parish.

In 2001, Rev. Krolikowski retired from teaching. He moved to Clarkson, Michigan, where he died at the Jesuit retirement home on April 10, 2007 at age 83.

Scope and Content

Walter P. Krolikowski's papers consist of 18.05 linear feet spanning from 1934-2000. The papers include correspondence, personal writings, teaching materials, and items pertaining to the Loyola University School of Education, Jesuit Community, and St. Ignatius College Preparatory. Also included are one photograph series and one audio/visual series. Individual items contain Spanish, Italian, Latin, Catalan, and German languages. Subjects include the School of Education, Society of Jesus, and Philosophy of Education Society. The collection is organized by subject, with each series containing chronological, alphabetical, or subject arrangement.

Series

Series 1: Personal, 1937-2000 (bulk 1963-1999), Boxes 1-3.

This series contains Rev. Krolikowski's membership newsletters, curriculum vitae, financials, homilies, family history, and military service papers. Folders are arranged alphabetically, and items contain Spanish and Italian languages.

Series 2: Correspondence, 1949-1999, Boxes 3-16.

This series includes correspondence within Loyola University Chicago, Loyola's School of Education, and Rev. Krolikowski's personal correspondence. Folders are arranged alphabetical-chronological, and items include Spanish and German languages.

Series 3: Writings, 1935-1995 (bulk 1961-1994), Boxes 16-22.

This series includes Rev. Krolikowski's article and essay manuscripts, as well as their corresponding notes and bibliographic materials. Krolikowski's writings are arranged chronologically, and contain items in Spanish.

Series 4: Teaching, 1963-1999, Boxes 22-30.

This series contains items relating to Rev. Krolikowski's tenure as a professor in the Loyola School of Education. The series is divided into three subseries as follows:

Sub-Series 4A: Course Materials, 1963-1999, Boxes 22-24.

This sub-series contains exams, syllabi, workbooks, and lecture notes. Folders are arranged alphabetically

Sub-Series 4B: Student and Faculty Evaluations of Rev. Krolikowski, 1977-1999, Boxes 25-26.

This sub-series contains student and faculty evaluations of various education courses taught by Rev. Krolikowski. Folders are arranged chronologically.

Sub-Series 4C: Student Dissertations and Theses, 1973-1995, Boxes 26-30.

This sub-series includes dissertations and theses written by Krolikowski's former students. Folders are arranged chronologically.

Series 5: Loyola University Chicago, 1960-1998, Boxes 30-34.

This series includes correspondence, reports, and proposals related to Loyola University Chicago. The series is divided into two subseries as follows:

Sub-Series 5A: School of Education, 1960-1997, Boxes 30-32.

This sub-series contains reports, minutes, search committees, and conferences within the School of Education. Folders are arranged by subject.

Sub-Series 5B: Loyola University Chicago, 1965-1998 (bulk 1979-1997), Boxes 32-34.

This sub-series contains Loyola University Chicago committee reports, proposals, minutes, and newspapers. Folders are arranged by subject.

Series 6: St. Ignatius College Preparatory, 1966-1994, Box 34.

This series contains trustee and committee reports for St. Ignatius College Preparatory. Folders are arranged chronologically.

Series 7: Philosophy of Education Societies, 1970-1998, Boxes 34-35.

This series contains newsletters, ballots, conference programs from the Philosophy of Education Society and Midwest Philosophy of Education Society. Folders are arranged by subject.

Series 8: Jesuit Community, 1964-1993, Boxes 35-37.

This series includes correspondence within the Loyola University Chicago Jesuit Community, Chicago Province, and Society of Jesus. It also contains task force reports, meeting minutes, and conference correspondence. Folders are arranged chronologically, and items contain Catalan, Latin, Italian, and Spanish languages.

Series 9: Events, 1940-1999 (bulk 1983-1997), Boxes 37-38.

This series contains event flyers, programs, and invitations for symphony performances, plays, and conference panels. Folders are arranged chronologically, and items contain Spanish and Italian languages.

Series 10: Reference, 1934-1998 (bulk 1974-1998), Boxes 38-40.

This series includes academic articles collected by Rev. Kolikowski, as well as newspaper articles, educational studies, and reports. Folders are arranged by subject and chronologically, and items contain Spanish and German languages. Academic articles are dated according to publication year.

Series 11: Photographs, 1950-1996, Box 40.

This series contains photographs of Rev. Krolkowski, his family, fellow seminarians, and landscapes. Folders are arranged chronologically.

Series 12: Audio/Visual Materials, 1965-1998 (bulk 1985-1989), Box 41.

This series contains audio cassettes, floppy diskettes, microfilm, and VHS tapes of lectures, papers, and references. Items are listed alphabetically by format, and have not been reviewed.

Series 13: Restricted, 1964-1988, Box 42-43.

This series includes Jesuit correspondence, insurance information, student records, applications, and faculty identification cards. Folders are arranged chronologically.
