### Biographical Sketch

Rosemary Victoria Donatelli was born to Italian parents on December 25, 1929 in Chicago, Illinois. Always a lover of music, she enrolled at Mundelein College and majored in music education with a minor in English and History. After Donatelli graduated magna cum laude in 1952, she moved to New York where she studied for her masters at Columbia University. While in New York, Donatelli wrote articles for the American Federation of Teachers Journal and the Saturday Evening Post, which were both very well received. It was during this period that Donatelli first began teaching. From 1952-1957 she was a teacher for the Chicago Board of Education and taught third grade in the New Rochelle Public School district.

She graduated from Columbia University in 1956 with a major in Voice and minors in Musicology and History. After, graduating, she moved back to her native Chicago due to family reasons, and started her long career at Loyola University in September 1957. From 1957-1961, Donatelli was an assistant professor in the Department of Education teaching twelve different classes. In the summer of 1961, she went on a Loyola University Study-Tour in Great Britain and Scandinavia studying educational systems. The following year, Donatelli embarked on an 18 month tour at Loyola's newly founded Rome Center. She was the only female faculty member during the Rome Center's inaugural year, 1962-1963, in which she assumed a motherly role to

the entire female student body, while teaching five different educational courses. Donatelli returned again to the Rome Center for the 1968-1969 school year. When she returned from Rome, she continued teaching several educational courses at Loyola's Water Tower Campus, which she continued to do for the rest of her career.

By June 1971, Donatelli had received her Ph.D. from the University of Chicago with a major in History of Education and a minor in Philosophy of Education. While there, she undertook a long but extensive and thorough study on Ella Flagg Young for her dissertation, but was unsuccessful in getting it published. In 1972, she was appointed as the Chairman of the Department of Foundations in the School of Education. The following year, she was promoted to the rank of Associate Professor of Foundations and also a member of the Graduate Faculty. In 1979, she received the honors of being part of the International Who's Who of Women in Education. That same year, she wrote a mini biography on the life of Flora Cooke. Donatelli remained professionally active until her untimely death in October 1980 at the age of 50.

Donatelli belonged to many professional educational associations during her lifetime, two of which she was most active in were the Midwest History of Education Society and the Philosophy Select Committee. Donatelli also was part of many committees at Loyola University including the Select Committee, Advisory Committee to Institute of Pastoral Studies, Committee on Undergraduate Scholarships, and the School of Education Dean's Council. She also was involved with student organizations such as Phi Delta Kappa, Che Theta Upsilon, Kappa Delta Epsilon, and the Student Education Association. In addition, many of her writings were published throughout her career.

### **Scope and Content**

The Rosemary V. Donatelli papers consists of 14.5 linear feet spanning the years 1957-1980. The collection consists of correspondence, class notes, research, grade sheets, lectures, supplementary material, doctoral student proposals, student profiles, committee and association papers, council and departmental meeting notes, publications, miscellaneous articles, bibliographic note cards, and evaluations. The main subjects included are Loyola University Chicago School of Education, lecture notes and materials, Ella Flagg Young, Flora Cooke, and the history of education in the world. The collection is organized by subject.
