Administrative History

The Office of Registration and Records was established as the Office of the Registrar in 1921. The first Registrar of the College of Arts and Sciences was George P. Shanley, S.J., who also served as Dean of the College. This office was established to document, record, and oversee all undergraduate student educational records. During the mid-1920s the professional schools – Law, Medicine, and Dentistry – established their own separate Registrars.

Scope and Content

The Registrar's records consists of 1.0 linear foot spanning the years 1923-1971 with the bulk of the records being from 1931-1947. The records reflect the tenure of Bertram J. Steggert, A.M., and include minutes, correspondence, reports, attendance and grade records, memos, telegraphs, pamphlets, brochures, enrollment statistics, and newsletters. Organization is chronological within series.

Series

Series 1: General, 1923-1946, Undated. Box 1

This series includes lists of commencement speakers, correspondence, reports, questionnaires, attendance and grades, and transcript lists.

Series 2: Enrollment Statistics, 1928-1946, 1970-1971, Undated. Box 1

This series includes reports on enrollment statistics from the College of Arts and Sciences, Downtown College, Summer School, and foreign language classes. It also includes enrollment statistics on Negroes, foreign students, non-Catholic, students, and veterans as well as historical enrollment data.

Series3: Academic Council, 1927-1947. Box 2

This series includes minutes and reports from Academic Council meetings.

Series 4: American Association of Collegiate Registrars, 1931-1935, 1942-1947, Undated. Box 2

This series includes correspondence, pamphlets, programs, newsletters, and reports. Of note are the effects of World War II on student enrollment and deferment.
