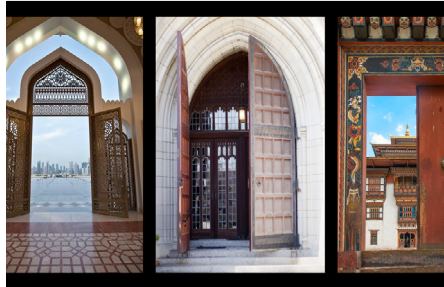


**Orthodoxy and two Father Brown Stories**

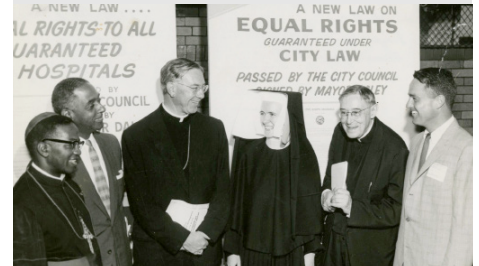

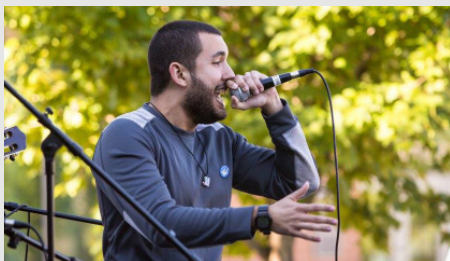
