Step 1: Check Your Account Summary by Term

Make sure all your expected financial aid is listed

Submit an Outside Scholarship Notification form for all external scholarships

Step 2: Check Your To-Do List in the Student Center

Resolve any of these issues:

Items still need to be submitted to the Financial Aid Office (FAO)

- □ Item Status is 2nd Notification Additional information is required - check with FAO
- □ Failed Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Complete SAP appeal with academic advisor and submit to FAO
- Complete MPN and Entrance Counseling for Stafford Loans
