

Devorah Schoenfeld is Associate Professor in the Theology Department at Loyola University Chicago. She earned her Ph.D. from the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley and MA from the Hebrew University in Jerusalem. She previously taught at St. Mary's College of Maryland, at University of California Davis, and at the Conservative Yeshiva. Her book "Isaac on Jewish and Christian Altars: Genesis 22 in Rashi and in the Glosa Ordinaria" was published by Fordham University Press in 2012. Her research interests include medieval Bible commentaries and Jewish-Christian relations and she has also published on dream interpretation in the Talmud and on proofs for the existence of God in medieval Jewish philosophy.
