Administrative History

These records cover the beginning of Chicago Women-Church which began about 1994 as a separate organization from Chicago Catholic Women (See written notes in File 1). It is a group based on the North side of Chicago. The mission statement of CWC, written about 1994 and reported on the CWC web site in 1997 identifies CWC as an egalitarian faith community. The statement describes CWC as a sacred circle of loving and powerful women dedicated to the continual exploration of the feminine and lists as a need “to be open to further exploration of who we are and what we want to be identified as, in various social and political terms (e.g. Catholic; Catholic; pro-choice; feminist; etc.)”

A September 22, 2003 visit to the CWC web site found a new mission statement developed at the fall 2000 retreat and still under discussion. The statement is shorter and more concise than the original statement. The community on its web site states that a past in Catholicism is common to many of us but “we reject the church’s sexism and hierarchal structure.”

The CWC usually meets twice a month at a rented house and has liturgy/rituals prepared by members with a later business meeting. There are usually Fall and Spring retreats. The requested yearly dues are \$50.00. The web site identifies LINKS that cover many other groups with similar goals. CWC is a member of Women Church Convergence and members attend its meetings.

On April 12, 1997 CWC celebrated its gift of its archives to WLA with a ritual “Preserving Our Past to Influence Our Future”. The ritual concludes with a song “Weaving A Revolution.” In May 1996 the community after detailed and extensive planning carried out an Ordination Ritual and Protest in front of Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago to promote the ordination of women. Stoles made by CWC were blessed and distributed. The program lists Sharing of Bread and Wine.

Scope and Content

The papers of Chicago Women-Church span the years 1993-2007 and document the creation of CWC as a faith community. There is a mission statement of around 1994 and a new mission statement of 2000. Correspondence with various organizations and many liturgies/rituals from the twice monthly meetings are included. A major activity in 1996 was the ordination ritual/protest. The materials have been organized according to their provenance. Given the limited amount of material, no series are outlined.
